

This award was established by the Board of Trustees in 1981 in honour of the founding Director of TST, Professor C. Douglas Jay, and is made possible thanks to contributions made by the Douglas and Ruth Jay Family Foundation.

Amount to be awarded: \$8,200

Application deadline: Friday, April 4, 2014, 5:00 pm

The award is available to an advanced degree student in TST, preferably a doctoral student, working in the area of Christian Social Ethics, who is a Canadian citizen, permanent resident or Protected Person, is a resident of Ontario as defined by OSAP, and has demonstrated financial need.

Applications will be judged on academic excellence (minimum of 3.7 average) and the quality of the research proposal.

The successful applicant(s) will be informed in early May 2014. Awards are conditional upon and will be disbursed following the award winner's registration for the Fall 2014 term.

Applicants should submit the following (except for the letters of support), all in <u>one</u> envelope labelled with the applicant's name and the name of the scholarship:

- Covering page.
- Applicant Statement indicating how he or she meets the criteria of the award.
- Statement of the applicant's research interest. For applicants at thesis stage, a copy of the thesis proposal meets this requirement.
- Unofficial transcripts or printouts of all courses and marks in their current program and degree immediately preceding current studies. (For finalists, the accuracy of the record will be verified against official transcripts on file).
- Statement of income and expenses demonstrating financial need. (Submit a copy of your OSAP application, a copy of a TST college bursary application form, or the TST Supplementary Financial Information Form.)
- Residency declaration form.
- Two letters of support. (Faculty members to email letters to <u>elizabeth.neilly@utoronto.ca</u> email
 <u>MUST</u> contain the name of the scholarship/bursary in the subject line and <u>MUST</u> be received by the application deadline in order to be considered as part of the application).
