



TST LANGUAGE EXAMINATIONS

- **Time:** All language exams will be held throughout the course of the day on Tuesday, September 3rd, 2024. Students registered for an examination will be informed of their precise language examination time at least one week in advance of the examination. All exams have a duration of one and a half (1.5) hours. Please arrive 15 minutes prior to the start time.
- **Remember to bring:** Pens (exams must be written in **black ink**, not pencil), your student photo ID, and, if applicable, your payment receipt.
- **Fee and Payment Options:** Exams taken by registered TST students to fulfill program language requirements are not subject to a fee (first attempt only). The fee for all other exams, including all exams taken to fulfill admission requirements, is \$42.75 per exam. PayPal is the method of payment. - **Registration:** To register, please do so via the online registration form by **12 noon on Wednesday, August 21, 2024**. If applicable, the fee must be paid in full by this date. If your supervisor has indicated that you require a language exam that is **not** listed above, please contact the Graduate Coordinator before **August 21, 2024**.
- **Dictionary:** All dictionaries and lexicons must be approved beforehand by the GCTS office. Please email gcts.office@utoronto.ca with a picture or link of your dictionary by **12 noon on Wednesday, August 21, 2024**. You may propose a bilingual dictionary or lexicon of your choice (e.g., French/English, Greek/English). Additionally, if your first language is not English, you may use a second lexicon (English/your first language). You must bring your own lexicon(s), which must be clean of all notes/annotations. No other aids, including computerized lexicons or digital devices of any type, are permitted.
- **Grades Required to Pass:**
French, German, Greek (non-biblical), Italian, Latin, Spanish: B-
Hebrew and Greek, competency (biblical) and proficiency: B+

Please note that these are only intended to give students a sense of the type of texts that may be used. Examiners are **not** obliged to follow the format of these samples. Students taking Biblical Hebrew or Greek exams (proficiency and/or competency) can expect the exam will draw from the following range(s):
 - Hebrew. Proficiency: Genesis 1-4; Exodus 15:1-21; Psalms 7, 24, 46. Competency: Genesis 1-2; 1 Samuel 24-25
 - Greek. Proficiency: Mark 1-8. Competency: John 2-5.
