



# TST LANGUAGE EXAMINATIONS

*French, German, Greek, Hebrew, Italian, Latin, Spanish*

- **Time:** All language exams will be held throughout the course of the day on Friday January 24, 2025. Students registered for an examination will be informed of their precise language examination time at least one week in advance of the examination. All exams have a duration of one and a half (1.5) hours. Please arrive 15 minutes prior to the start time.
- **Remember to bring:** Pens (exams must be written in **black ink**, not pencil), and your student photo ID.
- **Fee and Payment Options:** Starting January 2025, TST will no longer be charging for all language exams.
- **Registration:** To register, please do so via the online registration form by **12 noon on Friday, January 10, 2025**, and provide a photo of the dictionary/lexicon of choice. All dictionaries/lexicons must be approved by the GCTS beforehand. If your supervisor has indicated that you require a language exam that is **not** listed above, please contact the GCTS Director by **12 noon on Friday, January 10, 2025**.
- **Dictionary:** You may use a bilingual dictionary or lexicon (e.g., French/English, Greek/English). In addition, if your first language is not English, you are allowed to use a second lexicon (English/your first language). You must bring your own approved lexicon(s), which must be clean of all notes/annotations. No other aids, including computerized lexicons or digital devices of any type, are permissible.
- **Grades Required to Pass:**  
French, German, Greek (non-biblical), Italian, Latin, Spanish: B-  
Hebrew and Greek, competency (biblical) and proficiency: B+

Please note that these are only intended to give students a sense of the type of texts that may be used. Examiners are **not** obliged to follow the format of these samples. Students taking Biblical Hebrew or Greek exams (proficiency and/or competency) can expect the exam will draw from the following range(s):
  - **Hebrew.** Proficiency: Genesis 1-4; Exodus 15:1-21; Psalms 7, 24, 46. Competency: Genesis 1-2; 1 Samuel 24-25
  - **Greek.** Proficiency: Mark 1-8. Competency: John 2-5
